# Special Licence

Sections 22, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Good Creations Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **272 Glenmore Road Coatesville 0793** and known as **D:Stil Project** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): Gin School educational distilling experience for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

*(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act)* The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers by way of table service and a self-service area from the bar or side table.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
  - Saturday 12 March 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 19 March 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 26 March 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 09 April 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 30 April 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 14 May 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 21 May 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Sunday 29 May 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 04 June 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Sunday 19 June 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 02 July 2022 10am until 8pm**
  - Saturday 09 July 2022 10am until 8pm**
- (c) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages and food appropriate to the occasion.
- (d) Information regarding and assistance with alternative forms of transport must be available.
- (e) For the purposes of the licence a certificated manager is to be on duty at all times.
- (f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
  - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
- (g) The whole of the premises is designated as a **Restricted** area.

## Intoxication

Intoxicated people are not permitted on licensed premises. It is an offence to allow persons to become intoxicated here. It is an offence to serve an intoxicated person.

**Intoxicated people will be required to leave.**

## Minors

A current NZ driver's licence, a passport or Hospitality NZ 18+ card are the only types of ID that we can accept.
